

Day 1: Arrive in Fishguard



SAT PM

12:21 ARRIVE into Fishguard & Goodwick train station. There is a later train arriving at 18:51 (based on the Saturday train timetable).

Walk over to Fishguard along the seafront and up the steps or take a taxi if you've got a lot of luggage.

Sit down for lunch. Try Mannings Cafe (or choose from the cafe list under LUNCH at the end of this brochure).

Pick up some groceries from Mannings, Nourish, The Gourmet Pig or the Co-op (for more detail, see GROCERIES at the end of this brochure).

Wander around the shops. Visit the Last Invasion Tapestry in the Town Hall.

15:00 Fishguard (T11) > Mathry 15:17

You can request a stop at the end of our lane.

Walk down the lane to <u>PRESELI</u>
<u>VENTURE</u>. 16:00 check in, make yourself at home, take in the spectacular views.



SAT

WALK from PV down the lane and through the National Trust woodland to Abermawr beach (20 mins each way).



SAT

DINE at the Farmer's Arms in the local village of Mathry. Walk up on the bridleway (20 mins each way).

Day 3: Trefin and Porthgain Walk or Adventure Day

WALK from PV to Abermawr (1 mile) then take the coast path (South) to Trefin (+6.1 miles) or Porthgain (+7.7 miles).



LUNCH at The Ship in Trefin, or at
The Sloop or The Shed in Porthgain
with views over the historic harbour. Walk
back along the coast path, or take a bus.

Walk to Bay View Stores (3 mins). Pick up a freshly baked pastry for breakfast and a homemade salad box for your packed lunch with some locally caught, fresh dressed crab.



Walk along the main road to Llanungar Camping and Caravan Site (13 mins).

Day 4: St David's Climb + Kayak or Culture + History

TUE AM

08:02 Mathry > 08:27 St David's New St.

09:00-12:30 <u>ROCK CLIMBING</u>: traverse the craggy cliffs of the St David's peninsula.

LUNCH at Y Gegin or The Really Wild Emporium & check out the shop upstairs. 13:30-17:00 SEA KAYAKING (sit-on-top).



ALTERNATIVE: Visit the Bishop's Palace & St David's Cathedral. Pop into Mamgu in the Cathedral refectory to pick up some freshly griddled Welshcakes. Visit Oriel-y-Parc Parc, the National Park visitor centre, cafe and art gallery. Take a stroll around the shops.



Book to pick up your take—away woodfired pizza & some local craft beers from Grain before catching the bus home and warm it up in the oven later. Or book an early table at Grain before catching the 18:10 bus.

Walk over to Fishguard Ferry Port.

10:00-11:30 <u>FISHGUARD to STRUMBLE</u> <u>HEAD VOYAGE</u> boat trip - look out for seals!



WED Walk over to Fishguard for LUNCH at Ffwrn. Walk down to the harbour carpark in Lower Town Fishguard.

14:00-16:30 guided <u>SUP BOARDING</u> beginning in the harbour and then exploring a spectacular stretch of wild coastline.



17:00 Fishguard (T11) > Mathry 17:17. prepare a picnic and take it down to Abermawr beach. Make a driftwood fire on the pebbles and watch the sunset over the sea.



Day 6: Strumple Head Walk

THU AM

WALK from PV to Abermawr, then follow the coast path North to Strumble Head lighthouse (7.4 miles/ 3.5 hrs).

If you set out at 07:30 you can catch the 11:32 Strumble Head (404) > Mathry 12:03. Enjoy a hearty lunch at the Farmer's Arms.

If you set out at 12:15 you can catch the 16:22 Strumble Head (404) > Mathry 16:53. Celebrate with a drink at the pub.



THU **ALT.**

09:57 Mathry (404) > Garn Fawr car park (request stop) approx. 10:18

ALTERNATIVE WALK: Garn Fawr to Strumble Head Circular Walk (6.8 miles/ 3.5 hrs). Ample time for a picnic & wildlife watching from the wildlife hide at Strumble Head.

Approx. 16:30 - hail at Garn Fawr carpark (404) or walk to Trefasser Cross 16:34 > Mathry 16:53.

For a slightly shorter route, catch the 404 from Pontiago 16:12 instead (see map).



BBQ in the garden. Get excellent quality burgers, steaks and various cuts of lamb and chicken delivered in your C&M box (arrives frozen, defrost overnight on Weds).



Day 7: Walk + Newgale Surf

- A towel or changing robe and flip flops for sea activities.
- A water bottle and food containers for packed lunches.
- Bathers to wear underneath wetsuits (provided on activities).
- Warm layers for walking & wearing after sea activities.
- A waterproof/windproof jacket for boat trips and walking.
- Walking boots, walking shoes or trainers for the coast path. Some muddy stretches can be expected from the Autumn to Spring. In the Summer, walking sandals may be okay depending on the weather.
- A pair of old trainers for coasteering.
- A synthetic short/long sleeved T-shirt, or lightweight thermal top and a fleece for kayaking.
- A plastic bag to take wet gear home in.
- Bring a strap for glasses on activities or wear contact lenses.
- Packable binoculars for wildlife watching on walks.

This is a SAMPLE ITINERARY. Tides affect some of the water activities and activity timings vary from week to week, therefore your itinerary will look a little different to this one. Please remember to check whether the seasonal buses are operational during your visit. We recommend booking ahead for all cafes and restaurants, especially in high season. If you plan to use taxis, you will also need to book in advance.

BUSES

YEAR-ROUND BUSES:

- T11: the regular service bus from Fishguard to St David's (Mon-Sat only: no bus on Sundays).
- T5: the regular service bus from Fishguard to Newport (Mon-Sat only: no bus on Sundays).

SEASONAL BUSES:

- 404: The "Strumble Shuttle" coastal shuttle bus runs along the coast between Fishguard and St David's from May 24th to September 28th 2025.
- 403: The "Celtic Coaster" coastal shuttle bus runs around the St David's peninsula from April 12th to September 28th 2025.

WHERE TO CATCH THE BUS: The T11 service bus and the Strumble Shuttle (404) bus can be accessed at the Mathry Village bus stop, located in the centre of the village by the green, at the top of Mathry hill. To reach this bus stop, you can walk from Preseli Venture (turn right out of the entrance) and down the lane (2/3 of a mile) and then turn right up the hill into the village (1/3 of a mile). We advise leaving Preseli Venture about 30 minutes before the bus is due.

There is an alternative off-road route up to the village using the bridleway that leads off to the right as you walk down the lane: it's the only bridleway footpath leading off the road and is signposted to Mathry. This takes you straight to the village centre.

GETTING ON & OFF THE BUS AT UNDESIGNATED STOPS: The regular service buses will usually oblige, and when requested, will drop you off at a safe spot. When returning to Preseli Venture, you can ask to be dropped off at Mathry Crossroads, which is the crossroads at the end of the lane.

The coastal shuttle buses are always obliged to stop at a safe place as requested away from the bus stops, so do ask to be dropped off at the end of lane leading to Preseli Venture.

COSTS: Individual fares vary. A weekly bus pass offers the best deal, with adults at £34 and children at £16.



WELCOME HAMPER

Book your accommodation with us and add a welcome Hamper from The Paddock Farm Shop at the checkout costing £18 and including: Local fresh milk, freshly baked bread, a loaf of bara brith, freerange eggs and homemade jams and marmalades.

PICK UP GROCERIES in FISHGUARD

- Fishguard Country Market: every Thursday (09:00-14:00). Local meat, dairy, eggs and veg. This is a great place to buy fresh, locally sourced fish from the fishmonger.
- Mannings: a green grocers selling fresh local produce including lots of organic fruit and vegetables.
- Nourish: an excellent bakery selling Artisan sourdough loaves, focaccia, fresh croissants and other beautiful European pastries & cakes.
- The Gourmet Pig a European-style delicatessen with some local cheeses and wines.
- The Co-op: a medium sized, well-stocked supermarket.

C&M ORGANICS VEG BOX DELIVERY

C&M Organics' food box can be delivered to your door on Wednesdays including fruit, veg, meat, dairy, wholefoods and toiletries. Meat arrives frozen: once defrosted, we recommend having a sunset BBQ using the large grill in the back garden. Almost all their produce is certified organic and much of it is local or from their own farm. Create an account and place your order online by 09:00 am on Tuesday. Choose a bespoke veg box or a seasonal veg box/ fruit box. FARMERS ARMS in MATHRY (20 mins)

Only a 1-mile walk (20 mins each way via the lane & bridleway) up to the hilltop village for a family-friendly, hearty pub meal. Great for roast dinners by the roaring open fire. Open daily 12:00 to 23:00.

MELIN TREGWYNT CAFE (40 mins)

A traditional Welsh woolen mill only 40 minutes (2 miles) walk from Preseli Venture, which can be a circular walk including Abermawr & Aberbach. Breakfast is served 09:30-11:30 on weekdays and 10:00-11:30 on weekends. Lunch and afternoon tea is served daily 12:00 - 16:00. A maritime pub at the heart of the community, with a beer garden facing the cathedral.

THE FARMER'S ARMS

Another rustic local pub with a suntrap beer garden overlooking the cathedral and a hearty menu.

PRESELI VENTURE TO ABERMAWR

- Turn left out of Preseli Venture and head down the road.
- Shortly after passing through a farm, at the T-junction, turn left and follow the road until you meet a cluster of cottages, head through the gate signposted to Abermawr which is on the right.
- On this walking holiday itinerary, whenever you start at Abermawr, you'll be taking the coast path South. For this reason, you'll need to take the left hand path and at the next gateway, go through the kissing gate into the field, cross the field to the gate on the far side.
- A few metres past the gate, go up the steps to your left, bear right and follow the woodland trail towards the beach.
- This path brings you out into the South corner of Abermawr beach. The coast path veers off uphill to the left just as you reach the pebbles, signposted toward Abercastle.

ABERMAWR TO PRESELI VENTURE

- On the North side of the beach, you'll see a path heading uphill to the road. Instead of taking this, you'll need to go through a gate on your right (inland) into a field.
- Cross the field and you will find a stream with some stepping stones leading to a the gate.
- Go through the gate and follow the woodland path until you reach another gate, head through the gate into another field.
- Bear left across the field and go through a gate back into the woods.
- Follow the path that bears right and follow the path until you reach the road.
- At the road turn right and head back along the road and up the hill through the farm to Preseli Venture which will be on your right.



Approximately 1 mile each way.
